Subject: DCEO MPRD Keith Mione (Community) Park Traffic Signal Construction Contract Award

The construction contract award is in the amount of \$276,645.70.

Background

The Illinois Department of Commerce & Economic Opportunity (IDCEO) awarded the Village a grant in the amount of \$350,000 for improvements to be made at the Midlothian Road entrance to Mundelein Park & Recreation District's Keith Mione (Community) Park. The improvements include the cost of design and construction engineering and the installation of new traffic signals and related improvements to Midlothian Road and the park entrance drive. On February 5, 2015, construction bids were opened and read aloud. Even after the required duration and proper venues for posting of the request for bids, only one bid was received. Hometowne Electric, Inc., of Lake Villa, Illinois submitted the lowest responsive bid in the amount of \$276,645.70. The Mundelein Park & Recreation District has agreed to contribute up to \$28,000 towards the project. A preliminary summary of grant expenditures is as follows:

Recommendation

1. **Motion** to accept all submitted bids.
2. **Motion** to award a contract to Hometowne Electric, Inc., of Lake Villa, Illinois for the IDCEO MPRD Keith Mione (Community) Park Traffic Signal Project.
3. **Motion** to authorize the Mayor and the Village Clerk to execute a contract with Hometowne Electric, Inc., in the amount of \$276,645.70 subject to the receipt of required bonding and insurance.
